The Role

Event Assistance is the main communication hub of the event. As part of the Event Assistance team, you will have the crucial role of monitoring all the activity on the rider route and event sites. It's your role to communicate with the support vehicles, marshals and any riders or event team members who get in touch. You'll be recording all communications that take place and problem solving any issues that may come up. You'll always have someone there to escalate serious incidents.

Your role will include:

- Answering incoming phone calls and radio communications.
- Logging all calls and incidents and following up where required.
- Coordinating responses with medical, mechanical and SAG assistance.
- Maintaining communication with on-route teams.
- Alerting team leaders and event team members to situations requiring emergency services (fire, ambulance, police).
