The Event

With 7 ride options to choose from, the event inspires riders of all abilities to take on the challenge, from the 20km family-friendly ride to the 300km challenge ride around Port Phillip Bay. By volunteering on United Energy Around the Bay you will not only be helping others to achieve their personal goals but supporting Bicycle Network and our charity partner, Maddie Riewoldt's Vision. The Role

As part of the Motorcycle Marshal Team, you will be the eyes and ears out on route. You will be monitoring and stopping at strategic positions along route to be ready to assist any rider or route marshal and reporting any issues to event assistance.

Your role will include:

- Riding the route on your own motorcycle.
- Providing directions to riders and making sure they stay on the route and follow road rules.
- Maintaining regular communication with other marshals and event assistance using a radio, reporting on any traffic management or rider issues to report any incidents that may arise.
- Alerting riders to hazards (or clearing potential hazards) on the route.
- Providing immediate response to rider accidents and ensuring they receive assistance from first aid or emergency services.
- Dealing with incidents professionally and resolving problems effectively.
- Providing support and assistance to route marshals where necessary.
- Completing incident reports where necessary.

- Are you a strong communicator?
- Are you familiar with Victorian Road Rules and how they relate to cyclists?
- Do you have a valid motorcycle license and motorcycle?
- Do you have a current First Aid Level 2 Certificate? (preferable but not required)
- Can you be assertive while maintaining great customer service skills?
