With 7 ride options to choose from, the event inspires riders of all abilities to take on the challenge, from the 20km family-friendly ride to the 300km challenge ride around Port Phillip Bay. The Role

As part of the Rest Area Team, you’ll play an essential role in ensuring that riders have an enjoyable day on the bike! You’ll do this by ensuring they have a safe place to take a break and refuel before continuing on the ride.

Your role will include:

- Setting up and dismantling the rest area equipment, including marquees, tables, chairs, bike parking and signage.
- Marshalling riders safely into the site and ensuring a safe flow of riders through the rest area.
- Handing out food and electrolytes to riders.
- Providing excellent customer service and answering questions from riders, spectators and the public.
- Ensuring the site is kept clean, tidy, and free from litter.
