

#### **Active Travel on event days**

71.3%

on average. Highest day 78.26%



Average increase on event days

14.3%



On the first Open Streets day, 74.7% of students used some form of active transport to get to school (e.g. walk, bike, scoot, or skating). This is a 24.7% increase in active travel when compared to a normal school day in 2022.

### **Rode more**

55%

of families said that they rode more on Open Streets days.



### **Walked more**

32%

of families said that they walked more on Open Streets days.



### Felt safe to walk or ride on South Daly St

96%

of survey respondents felt that South Daly Street was safe to walk or ride on on trial days, compared to only 45% on normal school days.
