GET TO KNOW ORBOST

Our starting point for the 2023 Great Vic Bike Ride is the picturesque town of Orbost on the Snowy River and it offers a great taste of the adventure ahead, as there is no shortage of things to see and do.

Orbost has been home to the Krauatungalung people for tens of thousands of years, and also has a proud history of gold mining, timber harvesting and farming. The hard work continues on the farmlands around the town today and at the 100-year-old butter factory, where craft brewery Sailors Grave churns up delightful beers made from farmed and foraged ingredients.

The town features many remnants of its proud history that offer visitors a glimpse into its past, while there are plenty of reasons to escape into its scenic surroundings. So, once you've grabbed your rider pack, set up camp for the night and said g'day to your neighbours, get out and explore the area!

WHAT'S ON IN ORBOST

IN TOWN

Orbost Markets

Wander down the main street of Orbost and check out some of the local arts, crafts and live music on show at the market, open from 2pm until 6pm.

Orbost Bakery

Visit the local bakery from 10am-4pm for special Great Vic \$10 deals, including pie and drink, or coffee and cake or slice. Devonshire Tea will also be on offer for \$8.

East Gippsland Coffee Roasters

East Gippsland Coffee Roasters understand coffee can lead to many great adventures! Drop in for a cup of coffee in Orbost - roasted fresh onsite.

Grandview Lookout

Warm up the legs with a 22-minute ride from the campsite to the Grandview Lookout at Newmerella, overlooking Orbost's stunning green pastures and mountains.

Sailors Grave

Located at The Old Butter Factory, this craft brewery serves up some adventurous ales and will feature live music until late on Saturday.

Orbost Hotel

Established in 1884, this hotel serves up classic pub fare in classic surroundings.

Orbost Exhibition Centre

Come for the "Bits and Bobs" exhibition during the day but stay for the live "Funk & Punk" music until late. \$15 entry at the door.

Orbost Tennis Club

Get the body moving with some tennis and other activities at the Orbost Tennis Club. Gold coin donation.

Snowy River Bridge

Orbost is home to the longest wooden railway bridge in Victoria and there's a local campaign to refurbish it for walking and bike riding. Visit the bridge and check out www.savethesnowyrailbridge.org to learn more.

Self-guided river tour

Ride along the Snowy River and then paddle back downstream on a kayak or SUP, available for hire under the Snowy River Bridge. More information: 0439 419 468 or scan the QR code.



Free bus tour

Take a free two-hour bus trip along the Snowy River to Marlo, visiting Cape Conran, Salmon Rocks and the Marlo Jetty. Leaving the info centre at: 11am, 1pm, 2pm. And 3pm. Book via the QR code.


