The Event

[United Energy Around the Bay](#) is Australia's biggest bike ride, where more than 10,000 riders come together in celebration of our city, our people and the simple joy of riding bikes. With 6 ride options to choose from, the event inspires riders of all abilities to take on the challenge, from the 20km family-friendly ride to the 300km challenge ride around Port Phillip Bay. The Role

SAG stands for Support and Gear and the SAG Wagons are our on-route support vehicles which pick up riders who can't ride any longer. You need to be comfortable driving a 12-seater bus with a trailer. You will always have a co-driver to share the driving/navigating with.

Your role will include:

- Driving the route and picking up any riders who are unable to continue.
- Transporting riders.
- Assisting riders to securely place their bike on the trailer.
- Keeping a logbook of any riders who have been collected.
- Maintaining regular communication with Event Assistance and other support vehicles via a 2-way radio.



Is it right for you?

- Do you have a valid drivers license and are you comfortable driving a 12-seater bus with a trailer attached?
- Are you able to follow your team leaders' directions?
- Are you able to read and interpret maps and GPS references?
- Are you comfortable lifting objects up to 10kg?
- Do you have excellent communication and customer service skills?
- Are you confident driving around cyclists and understand the Victorian road rules?
- Do you have a valid Working with Children Check (WWCC)?
