In 2024, we are celebrating the 40<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the iconic event which started back in 1984. This year's ride takes us from Wodonga to Healesville, showcasing all the best parts of northeast Victoria. You can expect amazing scenery, charming host towns and of course, great company! This event couldn't happen without the support of more than 200 volunteers. Volunteering is a great way to share your skills, learn new ones, meet likeminded people, support the bike riding community, explore the Victorian countryside and be a part of an iconic event. ### The Role

Event Control is the main communication hub of the Great Vic Bike Ride. As part of the Event Control Team, you will have the crucial role of monitoring all the activity on the rider route and event sites. It's your role to communicate with the support vehicles, marshals and any riders or event team members who get in touch. You'll be recording all communications that take place and problem solving any issues that may come up. You'll always have someone there to escalate serious incidents.

Your role will include:

- Answering incoming phone calls and radio communications.
- Logging all calls and incidents and following up where required.
- Coordinating responses with medical, mechanical and SAG assistance.
- Maintaining communication with on-route teams.
- Alerting team leaders and event team members to situations requiring emergency services (fire, ambulance, police)
