On the days of the Open Streets trials, on average 87.3% of students used some form of active travel to get to school (e.g. walk, bike, scoot, or skating). This is a 22.9% increase when compared to a normal school day in 2025.

Congestion

71.4%

of local residents and/or parents noted that the streets surrounding Glen Huntly PS were 'always' or 'sometimes' congested.



Rode or walked to school

86.4%

On Open Streets days, 86.4% of families stated that they rode or walked to school, reducing car usage by 54.4%



Felt safe to walk or ride

of survey respondents felt that Garden Ave was safe to walk or ride on trial days, compared to only 75% on normal school days.
