Active Travel on event day

43.1%

of the student population rode on the Open Street event day.



Increase on event day

83.4%

increase of students actively travelling on the date of the Open Street trial.



On the day of the Open Streets trial, on 43.06% of students used some form of active travel to get to school (e.g. walk, bike, scoot, or skating). This is an 83.38% increase when compared to a normal school day in 2024.

Rode more

63.2%

of students felt that Open Streets made them want to actively travel to school more.



Walked more

33.3%

of families said that they walked more on Open Streets days.
