On the days of the Open Streets trials, on average 63% of students used some form of active travel to get to school (e.g. walk, bike, scoot, or skating). This is a 100% increase when compared to a normal school day in 2025.

Congestion

83.3%

of local residents and/or parents reported that the streets around Malvern Valley PS were 'sometimes' or 'often' congested during pick up and drop off times.



Ride or walk more

80%

of families said that they rode or walked more on Open Streets days.



Felt safe to walk or ride

92.9%

of survey respondents felt that Abbotsford Avenue was safe to walk or ride on trial days.
