

# Open Streets Trials Summary Report

## Nightcliff Primary School

### Friday 9th August 2024

#### Active Travel on event day

**49.5%**



On the day of the Open Streets trial, 49.5% of students used some form of active travel and \*public transport to get to school (e.g. walk, bike, scoot, or skating). This is a 63.9% increase when compared to a normal school day in 2024.

#### Increase on event day

#### Actively travelled to school

**90%**

% of parents were more likely to consider walking or riding on the Open Street activation day.



#### Active Travel post event

**30%**

of families said that they intend to actively travel more often after experiencing Open Streets.



#### Felt safe to walk or ride

**72.7%**

of respondents stated that Cunjevoi Crescent felt safer to walk or ride along during the Open Street trial days.



#### Would like to see regular Open Streets

**90.9%**

of respondents would like to see Open Streets as part of the annual school calendar at Nightcliff Primary School.
